Special MEC Meeting - Joint COVID-19 Task Force

31 March 2020

Earlier today, your ExpressJet MEC held a Special MEC Meeting via Zoom video conference. The whole of the meeting was held in executive session, barring the portion used to vote on a new resolution, details of which are discussed below. To start the meeting, MEC Chairman Captain Joe Mauro led an update on coronavirus-related concerns and planning for the future. This discussion included a briefing of Training Center activity and updates by your LEC 179 Flight Instructor Rep Captain David Oeswein.

The special meeting also included XJT Central Air Safety Committee (CASC) Chairman Paul Koziol, XJT Aeromedical Chairman Eric Adler, XJT Security Chairman Gilles Marty, and XJT CIRP Chairman Richard Hom. These chairmen worked diligently to draft Resolution 2003-06R ([attached](#)), which was unanimously passed by your XJT MEC today. Resolution 2003-06R outlines the creation of an XJT MEC Joint COVID-19 Task Force, on which these committee chairmen will all serve. The intent of this task force is to ensure the Association works with the company to make sure the work environment here at ExpressJet is the safest possible for our front-line employees in light of the COVID-19 pandemic. This resolution has been presented to management. It is the hope of the Association Joint COVID-19 Task Force members, and your Representatives, that management will see the need for this task force as we do agree to not only form the task force but also to implement the recommended proposals.

The meeting finished up with a briefing from your XJT MEC Negotiating Committee Chairman Captain Ivan Harris. This briefing included discussion of LOA 4, which covers the company's response to a pilot's exposure to COVID-19, which has been signed by all parties and is expected to be distributed to the pilot group either later this evening or early tomorrow.

The next regular MEC meeting is expected to take place in May, conditionally with current stay-in-place and social-distancing requirements.
